Beikthano Pyu City: located 19 km northwest of Taungdwingyi Township, Magway Region and 32 km from the east bank of Ayeayawaddy River, in the middle portion of the arid central plain of Myanmar. Archaeological research at Beikthano began in the early years of 20th century with the survey of Mr. Taw Sein Ko in 1905.

Hanlin city was burnt and destroyed in 9th century A.D. "Ancient Srikshetra", by U Sein Maung Oo, is an excavation report. The author led the excavation team and presents details about Srikshetra. Srikshetra was also an ancient Pyu city located just five miles southeast of Pyay (Prome). It flourished between the 5th and 10th centuries.

The Pyu cities are remarkable because of their spatial continuity, for their early achievements in water control, iron production, ritual and domestic ceramics, brick monumental architecture, rich funerary culture, literacy and adoption of Buddhism on both elite and popular levels.

From the Iron Age to early cities at Sri Ksetra and ...
This problem has not previously been addressed in Myanmar [Burmas], yet the earliest urban centres of South East Asia as a whole are the Pyu cities, situated in its great central plains. Sri Ksetra, the main focus of this research project, is the largest and most enduring of the Pyu sites, with the richest assemblage of material culture in the form of fortifications, monuments, sacred art and inscriptions.

Pyu Ancient Cities includes the remains of three brick, walled and moated cities of Halin, Beikthano and Sri Ksetra located in vast irrigated landscapes in the dry zone of the Ayeayarwady (Irrawaddy) River basin. They reflect the Pyu Kingdoms that flourished for over 1,000 years between 200 B.C and 900 A.D.

Humans lived in the region that is now Burma as early as 55,000 years ago, but archeological evidence dates the first settlements at about 2500 BCE with cattle rearing and the production of bronze. By about 1500 BCE, ironworks were in existence in the Irrawaddy Valley but cities, and the emergence of city states, probably did not occur until the early years of the Common era when advances in irrigation systems and the building of canals allowed for year-long agriculture and the consolidation of
